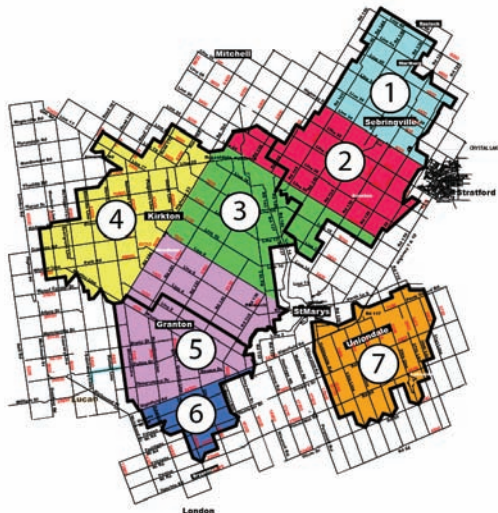

TECH TIP: MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR INTERNET SERVICE THIS SUMMER

Wifi, also known as wireless internet is supported by equipment called a router. The router is directly connected to the internet which then sends a signal much the same way a radio station sends radio waves. This signal area is limited and devices outside of that area will not be able to connect. Wifi technology enables your smartphones, tablets, gaming systems etc. to work in your home or office with no connection cables attached. As a rule a direct connection from your main internet source, in Quadro's case your modem or fibre terminal is always optimal. The router which "routes" your internet or broadcasts the wireless signal can at times degrade your connection causing a poor customer experience. It's important to know that our

world of technology is forever changing and the amount of devices we want connected is increasing. Investing in a wireless router that is suitable for the size of your home or business along with the amount of devices connected is a considerable factor in having the best internet experience. Don't forget about bandwidth. Additional bandwidth, also known as "speed" may be required to ensure all of your connected devices are working to their best ability. Don't let your internet slow you down this summer. Poor internet experiences can take time to solve through troubleshooting and education. QUADRO'S LEGACY PLANT REMOVAL

Quadro has started removing the brown pedestals that housed the technology that is no longer required and repairing (straightening) our current green pedestals within the serving area. Weber Contracting is assisting us the final phase of our fibre to the home project in the original four exchanges. This removal project is anticipated to be completed in 2018. Technicians are currently working in the area of Rostock and Sebringville. The map (pictured left) outlines each phase and where work will be completed.
