


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#### **Quadro's SmartHub App Update**

#### **CRTC News**

Canadian Radio-television Telecommunications

In compliance with new regulations mandated by the CRTC to reduce unwanted nuisance calls, Quadro will implement universal network-level call blocking ("UCB") beginning early 2020 on its wireline network, for all incoming voice calls. As per the CRTC's directives, UCB will block calls where the caller identification (i) exceeds 15 digits, or (ii) is malformed and does not conform to a dial able number for calls initiated under the North American Numbering plan. # Windows 7 End of Support What happens now?

When Windows 7 reaches its End of Life phase on **January 14, 2020**, Microsoft will stop releasing updates and patches for the operating system. It is anticipated that Microsoft will limit or possibly no longer offer help and support should you encounter any problems after this date.

However, that doesn't mean Windows 7 will stop working on that date. You will still be able to use Windows 7 for as long as you want.

The biggest issue with continuing to use Windows 7 is that it won't be patched for any new viruses or security problems once it enters End of Life, and this leaves you extremely vulnerable to any emerging threats.

So, while Windows 7 will continue to work after January 14 2020, you should start planning to upgrade to Windows 10, or an alternative operating system, as soon as possible.
