

5G TECHNOLOGY



The next evolution of technology is quickly approaching, with the introduction of 5G, estimated to arrive in 2019/2020. With 5G, 3 core elements have been the focus of this transition: 1. Greater Speeds (the ability to move more data) 2. Lower Latency (the ability to be more responsive) and 3. The ability to connect a lot more devices at once (including smart devices). These are designed to improve overall coverage with the expectation of 5G being up to 40X faster than previous 4G technologies. With 5G, smartphone devices will allow for more complex mobile internet applications to run and be more functional. 5G is anticipated to be the first major generation designed for our connected world, and the internet of things.

TECH TIP - HOW TO BACK UP YOUR DEVICE




One of the most Frequently Asked Questions we get in our iOS classes from our customers is wanting to know how to Back Up their iPhones. Here is a quick instructional guide to help you with this:

Back up your iPhone using iTunes

1. On the computer, start **iTunes**.
2. Connect the iPhone to the computer and select your **iPhone**.
3. Select **Back Up Now**.
4. Give your **iPhone** a few moments to complete the process; the **iPhone** should now be backed up to **iTunes**.

Back up your iPhone using iCloud

1. Tap **Settings**.
2. Tap your **Apple ID**.
3. Next, Select **iCloud**.
4. Tap on which Apps you want to be backed up to the **iCloud** (such as Photos, mail, Contacts)...
5. Tap **iCloud Backup** and tap **Back Up Now**  to back up your **iPhone**.
6. Give your phone a few moments to complete the process; your **iPhone** is now backed up to **iCloud**.

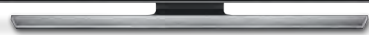

THE END OF AN ERA - DMS NO MORE!

Originally thought to be too elaborate for a four-exchange rural telephone system, the DMS-100 switch was installed in September 1993, and was the first Digital switch to be deployed in Ontario. The DMS-100 allowed for all communication traffic in the Granton, Kirkton, Sebringville and Uniondale exchanges to be routed through Kirkton and seemingly at the time, allowed for adequate capacity for what became a rapid increase in demand for connections due to the introduction of the internet and other telecommunications technology. However due to advancing technologies like the introduction and implementation of Fibre Optics, Quadro has now fully decommissioned the DMS-100 after 25 years of service.
